- 8. Today's bulletin includes** two articles: one on "Palms and Willows," and the other on "Pascha or Easter?" Take these home and share with your family.

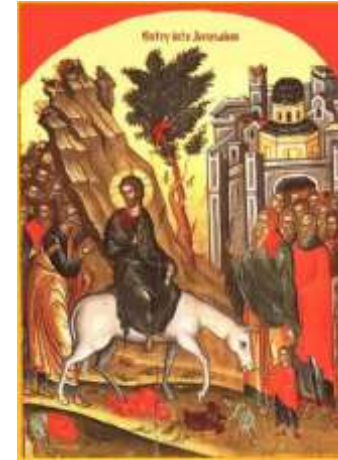
