**7. The monthly meeting** of the Parish Council will be held at the Council Retreat on Saturday, June 9. The Retreat begins at 9:00 am.

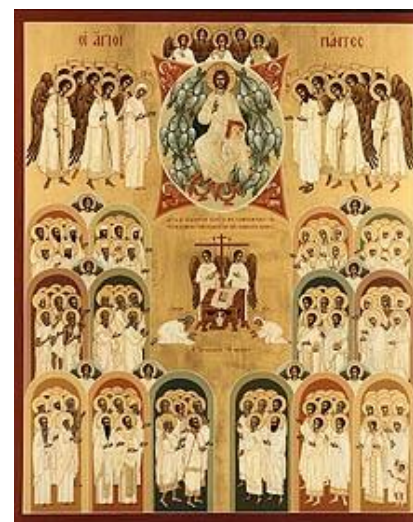
