

INTER-GENERATIONAL CHRISTIAN EDUCATION TO BEGIN OCTOBER 1

Under the direction of Fr. Frederick, St. Nectarios Orthodox Church Christian Education events will begin on Sunday, October 1. A 20-minute period will be devoted to Christian Education for all following Divine Liturgy on the First Sunday of each Month beginning in October.

The theme for this year's Christian Education will be:

ICONS OF THE TWELVE GREAT FEASTS

Class will discuss icons in general, and the icons of the feasts starting with the Nativity of the Theotokos icon on Oct. 1. Following a brief opening talk, copies of the icon of the day will be given to all, and Fr. Frederick will explain the icon and its significance for all ages. An icon to color will be provided for the children.

The class will last no longer than 20 minutes on the first Sunday of the month, and the blessing of the food for Coffee Hour will end the session. This is an opportunity for families to be together and grow in their Orthodox faith and understanding.
